Undergraduate Diploma – Instrumental/Vocal/Composition Study

Mission Statement: The Undergraduate Diploma program in Instrumental/Vocal/Composition study is a non-academic course of study that allows the student to concentrate on musical development in her/his area of interest. Generally undertaken as an adjunct to or in lieu of an undergraduate degree, this program emphasizes training in solo and large ensemble performance or music composition. Graduates are prepared to undertake further undergraduate study or to begin professional careers.

1. (performance). Students will be able to demonstrate mastery of basic performance techniques required to perform at a professional level.
1. (composition) Students will be able to demonstrate a thorough knowledge of compositional techniques, both traditional and experimental, for a range of ensembles: chamber, vocal, orchestral, and electronic.
2. (performance) Students will be able to perform publicly with confidence and assurance.
2. (composition) Students will be able to demonstrate knowledge of a wide range of contemporary repertoire and historical periods.
3. (performance) Students will be able to complete a public recital by successfully selecting, preparing, and performing demanding repertoire.
